Request that the City Council consider approving the minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas held on June 14, 2023.

## **ORDINANCE**

- O-1** Request that the City Council consider adoption of an Ordinance approving appointments to the Board of Directors of the Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone No. 4 (TIRZ No. 4).
- O-2** Request that the City Council consider adoption of an ordinance amending Tyler City Code Chapter 17, by adding, modifying, or removing speed limits for the East Erwin Street, FM 2767, Loop 323, North Church Avenue, Old Bullard Road, Palace Avenue, Pleasant Retreat Road, Skidmore Lane, South Vine Avenue, State Highway 155, US 271, and W Cumberland Road.
- O-3** Request that the City Council consider adoption of an ordinance amending Tyler City Code Chapter 17, by modifying or removing school speed zones for Andy Woods Elementary, Boulter Middle School, Caldwell Elementary, Clarkston Elementary, Cumberland Academy, Griffin Elementary, Hubbard Middle School, Jack Elementary School, Moore Middle School, Ramey Elementary, Rice Elementary, Tyler Legacy High School, and UT Tyler University Academy.
- O-4** Request that the City Council consider adoption of an Ordinance amending provisions in Tyler City Code Chapter 15, Franchises by amending Article VI. Rights-of-Way Use and Construction, including above ground facilities.

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

- M-1** Request that the City Council consider authorizing the City Manager to execute a Capital Improvement Project (CIP) contract with Striping Technology, LP. for the Traffic Signal Installations – Various Locations (new traffic signal at Grande Boulevard and Old Noonday Road, reconstruction of traffic signal at W. Gentry Parkway and W. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) project, \$1,057,847.80, Bid No. 23-023.
- M-2** Request that the City Council consider approving the allocation of funding in the amount of \$754,440 in Community Development Block Grant Funds (CDBG) and \$389,456 in HOME Grant Program funds from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024. These funds may be used to support projects that assist low-to moderate-income citizens, remove slum and blight, and or for urgent needs (disaster relief).
