

ORDINANCE NO. O-2017-21

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE INNOVATION PIPELINE'S EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHING PURCHASES WHICH WILL BE USED TO CREATE CONTENT FOR CHANNEL 3; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, this budget amendment will provide funding for the completion of the Innovation Pipeline project;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:**

**PART 1:** That the following line item accounts as approved in the budget for fiscal year 2016-2017 shall be amended to read as follows:

**PART 2:** That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of this budget amendment as required by state law.

**PART 3:** That amendment of the fiscal year 2016-2017 Budget is required in order to provide funding for items related projects and purchases started but not finished during the 2015-2016 fiscal year creates an urgent public necessity to authorize the amendment to the budget herein contained.

**PART 4:** That the following line item accounts as approved in the budget for fiscal year 2016-2017 shall be amended to read as follows:




