

ORDINANCE NO. O-2017-29

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017 AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE LAKE STREET CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to protect the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, there was an urgent need to proceed with replacing the failed drainage structure at Lake Street near Elizabeth Drive; and

WHEREAS, The Brannon Corporation was hired to perform the design and bid the construction phase; and

WHEREAS, the bid were opened and the lowest bid was above the budgeted amount, but funds are available in fund balance if appropriated by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Capps-Capco Construction Inc. submitted the lowest bid for the drainage work on Lake Street; and

WHEREAS, expenditure of funds for the Lake Street Culvert Replacement Project and drainage improvements associated therewith is considered to be in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following line item accounts as approved in the budget for fiscal year 2016-2017 shall be amended to read as follows:

PART 3: That amendment of the fiscal year 2016-2017 Budget is required at this time in order to provide funding for the Lake Street drainage improvements, which creates an urgent public necessity to authorize the amendment to the budget herein contained.

PART 4: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the City Council.


