

ORDINANCE NO. O-2017-37

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, ON THE 6th DAY OF MAY, 2017, FOR THE ELECTION OF A CITY COUNCILMEMBER FOR DISTRICT NO. 5 AND AFFIRMING THE CANCELLATION OF THE ELECTION AND DESIGNATION OF UNOPPOSED WINNERS FOR CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT NO. 1 AND CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT NO. 3., DECLARING THE WINNERS, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of May, 2017, the City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas, at a meeting duly called for the purpose, canvassed the returns of the City Council Election held on the 6th day of May, 2017, in the City of Tyler, for the election of a City Councilmember for District No. 5, for the City of Tyler, Texas, and it appearing as a result of such canvass that the following named persons received the following number of votes for City Councilmember, District No. 5:

District No. 5, For City Councilmember

Alan J Lizarraga	222 Votes
Bob Westbrook	621 Votes

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has certified in writing that the candidates for District No. 1 and District No. 3 were unopposed and that no write-in candidates had filed to be placed on the list of write-in candidates for those places; and

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code Sections 2.051 through 2.054 authorize the City Council to declare the unopposed candidates elected to office and cancel the unneeded elections;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Linda Sellers be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 1, to serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 2: That Ed Moore be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 3, to serve for a two-year term of office.


PART 3: That Bob Westbrook be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 5, to serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 4: That the City Council Election for District No. 1, and District No. 3, scheduled for May 6, 2017, was cancelled and such cancellation is hereby affirmed.

PART 6: That the above named City Councilmembers for District No. 1 and District 3 shall be sworn into office in the same manner provided for candidates that would have been elected at the election, and shall each serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 5: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
