

ORDINANCE NO. O-2015-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF TYLER ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS; BY APPROVING A ZONE CHANGE FROM "M-1", LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT TO "DBAC", DOWNTOWN BUSINESS, ARTS AND CULTURE DISTRICT ON LOTS 5D AND 11A OF NCB 18, TWO LOTS CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 0.27 ACRES LOCATED NORTH OF THE NORTHWEST INTERSECTION OF EAST ELM STREET AND SOUTH CENTER AVENUE (107 S. CENTER AND 115 S. CENTER); DIRECTING THE AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING MAP; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Tyler, Texas, and the City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas, in compliance with the Charter and the State law with reference to the zoning ordinance of the City of Tyler, Texas, and zoning map, have given requisite notices by publication and otherwise and after holding a due hearing and affording a full and fair hearing to all the property owners, generally and to the persons interested, situated in the affected area and in the vicinity thereof, the City Council is of the opinion that the zoning change should be made as set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following zone change is hereby approved as follows:

I. APPLICATION Z12-14-011

That the following described property, which has heretofore been zoned "M-1", Light Industrial District, shall hereafter bear the zoning classification of "DBAC", Downtown Business, Arts and Culture District, to wit:


Lots 5D and 11A of NCB 18, two lots containing approximately 0.27 acres located North of the Northwest intersection of East Elm Street and South Center Avenue (107 South Center and 115 South Center).

PART 2: That the City Manager is hereby ordered and directed to cause the zoning map to be amended to reflect the above described zoning.



PART 4: That this ordinance shall be effective on and after its date of passage and approval by the City Council.


