

ORDINANCE NO. 0-2015-9

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE NORTH AND SOUTH LOW ROOFS AT TYLER CITY HALL; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, during fiscal year 2014-2015, various purchases and projects were authorized; and

WHEREAS, the bids for the replacement of the north and south roofs at City Hall came back higher than expected; and

WHEREAS, this budget amendment will provide funding for completion of the replacement of the north and south low roofs at Tyler City Hall;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following line item accounts as approved in the budget for fiscal year 2014-2015 shall be amended to read as follows:

PART 2: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of this budget amendment as required by state law.

PART 3: That amendment of the fiscal year 2014-2015 Budget is required in order to provide funding for the completion of the replacement project for the north and south roofs at City Hall; and creates an urgent public necessity to authorize the amendment to the budget herein contained.

PART 4: That if any provision or any section of this ordinance shall be held to be void or unconstitutional, such holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions or sections of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

PART 5: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
