

ORDINANCE NO. O-2014-35

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, ON THE 10th DAY OF MAY, 2014, FOR THE ELECTION OF THE MAYOR AT LARGE AND CITY COUNCILMEMBER FOR DISTRICT NO. 4 AND AFFIRMING THE CANCELLATION OF THE ELECTION AND DESIGNATION OF UNOPPOSED WINNERS FOR CITY COUNCILMEMBER DISTRICT NO. 2 AND CITY COUNCILMEMBER DISTRICT NO. 6., DECLARING THE WINNERS, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on the 21ST day of May, 2014, the City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas, at a meeting duly called for the purpose, canvassed the returns of the City Council Election held on the 10th day of May, 2014, in the City of Tyler, for the election of Mayor at Large and a City Councilmember for District No. 4, for the City of Tyler, Texas, and it appearing as a result of such canvass that the following named persons received the following number of votes for Mayor at Large, and City Councilmember, District No. 4:

Mayor At Large

Martin Heines	3,040 Votes
Joel Rando	278 Votes

District No. 4, For City Councilmember

Eleno Licea	301 Votes
Donald Warren	444 Votes

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has certified in writing that the candidates for District No. 2 and District No. 6 were unopposed and that no write-in candidates had filed to be placed on the list of write-in candidates for that place; and

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code Sections 2.051 through 2.054 authorize the City Council to declare the unopposed candidates elected to office and cancel the unneeded elections;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Martin Heines be and is hereby declared the duly elected Mayor At Large to serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 2: That Darryl Bowdre be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 2, to serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 3: That Don Warren be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 4, to serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 4: That John Nix be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 6, to serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 5: That the City Council Election for District No. 2, and District No. 6, scheduled for May 10, 2014 was cancelled and such cancellation is hereby affirmed.

PART 6: That the above named City Councilmembers for District No. 2 and District No. 6 shall be sworn into office in the same manner provided for candidates that would have been elected at the election, and shall each serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 5: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
