

RESOLUTION NO. R-2016-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS EXPRESSING THE CITY COUNCIL'S SUPPORT FOR AND AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE A DEFENSE AND INDEMNIFICATION TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE BEEN SUED AS A RESULT OF ACTIONS TAKEN AS CITY EMPLOYEES; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, certain employees and contract employees have been sued as a result of actions taken as City employees and/or contract employees in a lawsuit entitled:

CARL OWENS, JR. and CONNIE OWENS vs. KOURT BEAU CHATELAIN, M.D., JAMIE CHATELAIN, THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, GREGORY M. MORGAN, in his capacity as Director of Utilities and Public Works for the City of Tyler, and KEVIN HUKILL, in his capacity as Water Production and Water Quality Manager for the Tyler Water Utilities Division for the City of Tyler, Cause No. 65,094-A, County Court At Law No., Smith County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City's investigation of the events involved in this lawsuit and the evidence available at this time, show that these named employees were acting in good faith and acted appropriately in the course and scope of their duties as City of Tyler employees; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest as well as the individual employees' interest for the Tyler City Council to state officially its support for them by providing a defense and agreeing to their indemnification, based upon all information and evidence available to date;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:




