
WHO WE ARE

BEE CITY USA

Did you know the United States is home to more than 3,600 native bee species? Pollinators touch our lives in numerous ways daily, including being responsible for approximately one-third of the food and drink we consume, with an estimated value of \$22 billion annually in the U.S.

Due to pollinators' importance in everyday life, Keep Tyler Beautiful became an affiliate of Bee City USA in 2019 to protect pollinators through education, outreach, and habitat creation.



Observation Hive

In 2021, Keep Tyler Beautiful unveiled the Honeybee Observation Hive at the Tyler Municipal Rose Garden, allowing visitors to get a closer look at the inner workings of a beehive. The structure was built by a local group of Boy Scouts under the direction of the East Texas Beekeepers Association.

National Pollinator Week

National Pollinator Week is an annual celebration in June to raise awareness for pollinators and spread the word about what we can do to protect them. Keep Tyler Beautiful celebrates National Pollinator Week through Facebook events and contests, along with providing resources and activities on our website at KeepTylerBeautiful.com.



Bee Day in the Garden

Bee Day in the Garden is hosted annually at the end of June as a closing ceremony to National Pollinator Week and a celebration of all things bees for the whole community.

Local honey vendors and organizations have booths for visitors to explore, food trucks, kids' activities, and educational workshops.

LITTER ABATEMENT

According to current estimates, 250 pieces of litter exist for every American on U.S. roadways, waterways, and other locations. Keep Tyler Beautiful is doing its part to help keep Tyler litter-free by utilizing volunteers to clean up litter, educating the public about the effects of debris, and encouraging people to dispose of their waste correctly through recycling and composting. The most common forms of litter found are cigarette butts, plastic film, packaging styrofoam, and food & beverage containers.



Adopt a Spot

Last year, more than 2000 volunteers removed nearly 5 tons of litter from Tyler area Parks, streets, and waterways through the Adopt a Spot Program. Adopt a Spot allows organizations, businesses, and other groups to adopt a street, park, or location where they complete at least one cleanup each quarter. KTyB provides supplies like litter grabbers, trash bags, gloves, and safety vests to the groups to achieve their cleanups safely. Each group is recognized on signage at their adopted location and on our website.

Great Tyler Cleanup

Great Tyler Cleanup is an annual litter pickup event hosted in April with Keep America Beautiful Great American Cleanup and the Don't Mess with Texas Trash-off. In 2023, more than 500 volunteers came to 16 locations to collect more than 2,700 pounds of litter.



RECYCLING

According to Recycle Across America, statistics show that Americans throw away 2.5 million plastic bottles every hour, throw enough aluminum to build our nation's entire commercial air fleet, and throw away enough office paper each year to build a 12-foot-high wall from Seattle to NY! In response, Keep Tyler Beautiful is doing its part by organizing multiple community events and projects across Tyler to encourage people to recycle.



Tyler Recycles Day

Tyler Recycles Day is Keep Tyler Beautiful's most popular community collection event, held annually in November, joining thousands of local organizers holding recycling events nationwide to celebrate America Recycles Day. Last year, we collected 5,700 lbs. of documents that were shredded on-site and more than 500 lbs. of batteries, tires, mattresses, electronics, and more.

Christmas Tree Recycling

The Christmas Tree Recycling Program provides Tyler residents with locations for Christmas tree recycling in Tyler. Residents can drop off undecorated, non-flocked natural Christmas trees in designated locations starting the day after Christmas. The trees are available for area fishermen to pick up and sink in nearby lakes to create fish habitats or be picked up at the curb for disposal at the landfill.



Recycled Art Contest

Recycled Art Contest is hosted annually from January through March and is open to artists of all ages. The theme for the 2023 contest was "Don't Trash Texas," which celebrates the proud spirit of Texans and the beauty of the State and its culture. Then, the select entries, including winners, will be displayed during the "Art in the Garden" at the Rose Garden Center.

Paint Recycle Day

Paint Recycle Day is a paint collection event hosted by Keep Tyler Beautiful and the City of Tyler Solid Waste Department every two years. The most recent event was held on Saturday, May 20, 2023, with the next event tentatively scheduled for Summer 2025.



BEAUTIFICATION

To promote the beautification of our city, Keep Tyler Beautiful has dedicated much effort to support, encourage, and award residents in keeping Tyler beautiful. Starting right from residents' own yard to public traffic boxes and walls! We believe that Keeping Tyler Beautiful is a community effort and in response, we have organized numerous ongoing beautification programs available for all of Tyler residents.

Art Murals Program

The Art Mural Project program gives local artists the opportunity to paint on designated walls in Tyler in mission to help encourage beautification in Tyler.

Past Art murals include: "Keep Tyler Beautiful" Mural located along South Loop 323, "Welcome to the Rose Capital" Mural located at 1718 W. Houston St., and several murals on Tyler Area park restrooms.



Beauty & the Box Program

The Beauty and the Box Program began in 2016 as a way to support local artists and bring artwork to all corners of Tyler. The artwork, submitted by local artists, is transformed into a vinyl wrap which covers the traffic signal box transforming the average into beautiful art.

The Beauty and the Box program has since been a great way to encourage and show residents the beautification of Tyler.

Tyler Against Graffiti Program

The Tyler Against Graffiti Program was organized for the purpose of preventing illegal graffiti and vandalism on any residential or commercial property. Our goal with this program is to remove any graffiti within 72 hours of a report free of charge. T.A.G. ensures the city's beauty with these strategic cleanups that also discourage further vandalism.



KTyB Park Marshalls

This program, beginning in 2024, will enlist the help of residents who want to get more involved with Keep Tyler Beautiful by helping monitor and cleanup our Parks and public spaces. KTyB will provide supplies, training and other resources to these volunteers.

RECOGNITION & AWARDS

Keep Tyler Beautiful encourages citizen stewardship through several recognition programs. Our goal is to celebrate those that are going above and beyond to help keep Tyler beautiful by taking pride in their property or spreading the mission of KTyB through their actions and volunteerism.



Beauty & Bloom Award

The Beauty and Bloom Award has recently started in 2023 to present a Beauty and Bloom Residential Landscaping Award certificate and yard sign to one Tyler resident from each district. By awarding those residents who keep their property beautiful and clean we hope to motivate others in the City to do the same.

Beauty & Business Award

The Beauty and Business Award presents a Beauty and Business Award certificate and yard sign to a business each quarter to recognize businesses in the community for their improvement, upkeep, cleanliness and beautification efforts. By awarding those businesses who keep their property beautiful and clean, it is our hope to motivate others in the City to do the same.



Campus Affiliate Program

Engaging youth in sustainable practices and volunteerism helps to instill these values later in life. Through the Campus Affiliate Program, KTyB aims to create new and strengthen current green clubs on Tyler area school campuses. By providing support and resources along with education and volunteer opportunities, it is our hope to influence the next generation of Tyler residents to live greener lifestyles.

Environmental Awards

These awards are a new addition to the Keep Tyler Beautiful recognition series. We aim to involve the community in nominating fellow citizens, groups, organizations and businesses who exemplify the KTyB mission.



OTHER EVENTS & PROGRAMS


Earth Day Festival

Started in 2022, Keep Tyler Beautiful saw an opportunity to create a community-wide celebration event to coincide with Earth Day. This event brings together local artisans, environmentally friendly businesses and educational opportunities at an all-day celebration in one of Tyler's parks.



Park Service Day

Park Service Day is an annual event that gives Tyler residents an opportunity to help beautify community parks through several restoration projects. Each September on Park Service Day, hundreds of volunteers participate in beautification projects such as litter cleanups, flowerbed restoration, painting, replacing mulch at playgrounds, and various other activities. Park Service Day has been a great way for residents to give back to neighborhood parks and the community itself.



Tyler Grow Green Program

The Grow Green Program encourages local gardeners and property owners to educate themselves about the chemicals they are using to maintain their landscapes by providing education and resources about native planting and integrated pest management. These plans are also implemented city-wide by the Parks and Recreation Department who maintain all 28 city Parks, along with the trails and Tyler Municipal Rose Garden.
