

**SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT YEAR 2025-2029 CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND
PROJECT YEAR 2025 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC
HEARING**

The City of Tyler receives the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) each year from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Every five years, HUD regulations require the City of Tyler to create a five-year consolidated plan to analyze its needs and develop projects and programs to address those needs.

Based on the current Needs Assessment and Market Analysis from the Consolidated Plan, the City of Tyler has identified four priority needs: (1) Non-Housing Community Development; (2) Decent and Affordable Housing; (3) Addressing Homelessness; and (4) Public Facilities Improvements.

In Program Year 2025, the City of Tyler expects to receive an estimated \$755,127.00 in CDBG funds and an estimated \$304,153.31 in HOME funds. These budgets will be proportionally increased or decreased from the estimated funding levels to match any changes to the actual allocation amounts, ensuring responsible financial management. To address the above needs, the City of Tyler intends to fund the following projects in the stated amounts:

Administration: \$151,025.00 or 20% in CDBG funds and \$30,415.00 or 10% in HOME funds

Critical Home Repair/ ADA Project: \$226,538.00 or 30% in CDBG funds

Public Facilities Projects: \$377,564.00 or 50% in CDBG funds

First-Time Homebuyers Projects: \$60,830.00 or 20% in HOME funds

Targeted Home Reconstruction/ New Construction Projects: \$167,286.31 or 55% in HOME funds

CHDO Reserve: \$45,622.00 or 15% in HOME funds

Each of the above projects addresses at least one priority need.
