


South Tyler Mobility Study



CENTENNIAL PARKWAY

The City of Tyler is proposing a 1.75-mile extension of Centennial Parkway from Settlers Landing to Paluxy Drive.

Centennial Parkway would be constructed as a three-lane roadway with sidewalks and bike lanes. Other proposed work includes constructing a bridge over Shackleford Creek and adding turn lanes at intersections. It is estimated that 5,000 vehicles per day would use the Centennial Parkway extension.

PROJECT BENEFITS:



Improves connectivity.



Facilitates connection to future development in the area.



Improves emergency response times.

CONSIDERATIONS FOR THE PROPOSED PROJECT:

- Right of way would be needed.
- Project funding has not been identified.



The estimated cost for these proposed improvements is \$26 million.
