


South Tyler Mobility Study



CHERRYHILL DRIVE

The City of Tyler is proposing a 0.5-mile extension of Cherryhill Drive from Hidden Creek Trail to W. Cumberland Road.

Cherryhill Drive would be constructed as a two-lane roadway with sidewalks, bike lanes, and turn lanes at intersections. It is estimated that 2,000 vehicles per day would use the Cherryhill Drive extension.

PROJECT BENEFITS:



Improves connectivity.



Facilitates connection to future development in the area.



Improves emergency response times.

CONSIDERATIONS FOR THE PROPOSED PROJECT:

- Right of way would be needed.
- Project funding has not been identified.



The estimated cost for these proposed improvements is \$8.8 million.
