


South Tyler Mobility Study



HOLLYTREE DRIVE

The City of Tyler is proposing a 1-mile extension of Hollytree Drive from Old Jacksonville Highway to Legacy Bend.

Hollytree Drive would be constructed as a two-lane roadway with sidewalks and bike lanes. Other proposed work includes constructing a bridge over West Mud Creek, building a protected pedestrian crossing at the existing trail, and adding turn lanes at intersections. It is estimated that 2,000 vehicles per day would use the Hollytree Drive extension.

PROJECT BENEFITS:



Improves connectivity.



Facilitates connection to future development in the area.



Improves emergency response times.

CONSIDERATIONS FOR THE PROPOSED PROJECT:

- Right of way would be needed.
- Project funding has not been identified.



The estimated cost for these proposed improvements is \$19.7 million.
