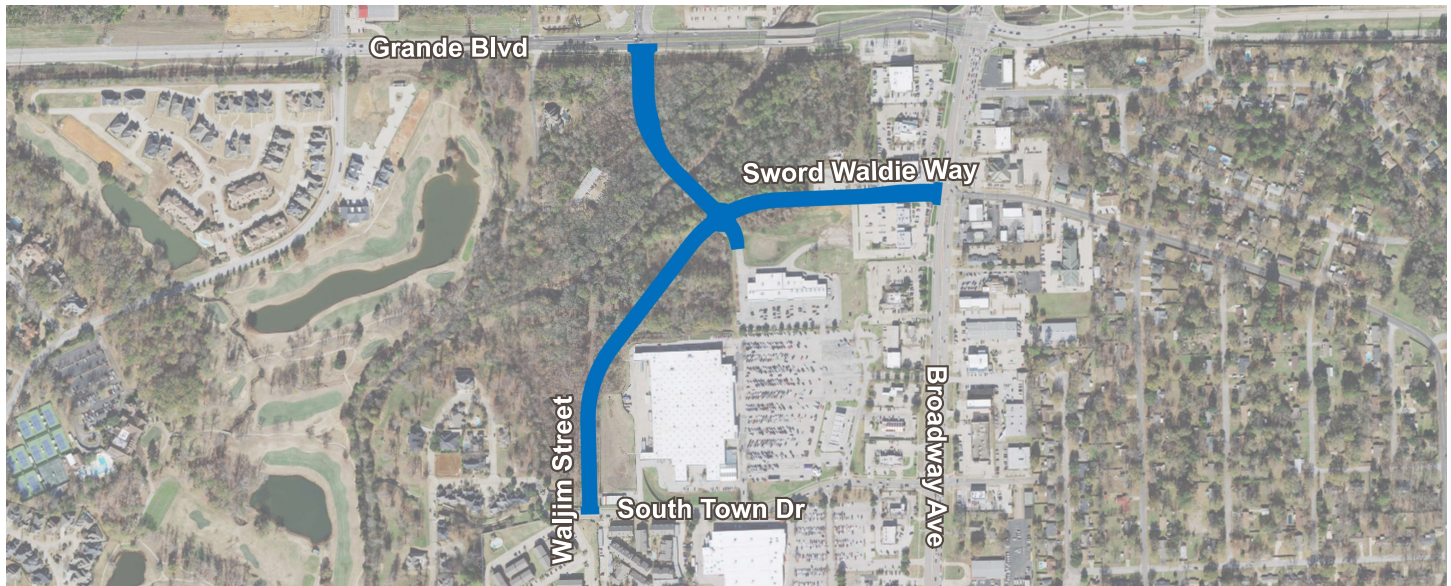


# South Tyler Mobility Study



## WALJIM STREET NORTH

The City of Tyler is proposing a 0.7-mile extension of Waljim Street from Grande Boulevard to Sword Waldie Way and South Town Drive.

Waljim Street North would be constructed as a two-lane roadway with sidewalks and bike lanes. Other proposed work includes constructing a bridge over West Mud Creek, adding turn lanes at intersections, and constructing a roundabout to facilitate connectivity. Approximately 8,000 vehicles per day are projected to use the Waljim Street North extension.



The estimated cost for these proposed improvements is \$14.9 million. At this time, the estimate does not include right-of-way acquisition costs.

## PROJECT BENEFITS:



Provides significant improvement in traffic operations.



Improves connectivity.



Facilitates connection to future development in the area.



Provides secondary access to businesses along Broadway Avenue.



Improves emergency response times.

## CONSIDERATIONS FOR THE PROPOSED PROJECT:

- The project needs to consider and avoid floodplain impacts.
- Right of way would be needed.
- Project funding has not been identified.
