


South Tyler Mobility Study



WALJIM STREET SOUTH

The City of Tyler is proposing a 1-mile extension of Waljim Street from Heritage Drive to Cumberland Road.

Waljim Street South would be constructed as a two-lane roadway with sidewalks and bike lanes. Other proposed work includes constructing turn lanes at intersections and adding a connection to Deer Ridge Lane. It is estimated that 6,000 vehicles per day would use the Waljim Street South extension.

PROJECT BENEFITS:

-  Provides significant improvement in traffic operations.
-  Improves connectivity.
-  Facilitates connection to future development in the area.
-  Improves emergency response times.

CONSIDERATIONS FOR THE PROPOSED PROJECT:

- Right of way would be needed.
- Project funding has not been identified.



The estimated cost for these proposed improvements is \$15.9 million.
