

**RESOLUTION NO. R-2025-17**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION GRANT FUNDS FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICE FOR TYLER TRANSIT FOR OPERATING, PLANNING, & PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE TOTALING \$5,140,893; AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION GRANT TX-5307 FOR FY2023 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,616,937 AND FY2024 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,523,956, ALONG WITH ANY GRANT AMENDMENTS TO INCREASE THE GRANT FUNDING LEVELS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on February 26, 2025, the City of Tyler was notified by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to make an application under the FTA Grant TX-5307 Main Grant requesting assistance for FY2023 in the amount of \$2,616,893 and FY2024 in the amount of \$2,523,956, for a grand total of \$5,140,893 for public transportation assistance and for vehicle purchases for Tyler Transit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tyler City Council must authorize submission of the application for FTA funds, as well as acceptance of the FTA Grant TX-5307 Main Grant for FY2023 in the and FY2024 in the aforementioned amounts, along with any grant amendments to increase the grant funding levels along with; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant supplies reimbursement for a portion of Transit Department operating costs. Remaining funds come from the adopted budget, departmental revenue, and State grant funds. If the City of Tyler did not receive this grant, the City would be responsible for all operating expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, it is considered to be in the public interest to obtain and use grant funds for the above public purposes;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:**

**PART 1:** That the Application for Federal Assistance for Project No. TX-5307 Main Grants requesting a total of \$5,140,893, for FY 2023 in the amount of [insert amount] and FY 2024 in the amount of [insert amount], for Operating, Planning, & Preventative Maintenance for Tyler Transit and including all understandings and assurances contained therein, is hereby authorized and approved.

**PART 2:** That the City Manager's filing of the grant application, and all actions taken in connection therewith, are hereby affirmed.

**PART 3:** That the City Council hereby resolves and affirms to the Federal Transit Administration that the City of Tyler has legal authority to apply for the grant and to finance and carry out the proposed project.

**PART 4:** That the City Council hereby resolves and affirms to the Federal Transit Administration the City of Tyler's intent to comply with all of the assurances set forth in the grant agreement and all laws, regulations, and circulars incorporated by reference in the grant agreement.

**PART 5:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to accept the grant for Project No. TX-5307 for FY 2023 and FY 2024 for Operating, Planning, & Preventative Maintenance, and any grant amendments to increase the funding levels.

**PART 6:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary in order to accept and use the grant to fulfill the purposes described above.

**PART 7:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide such additional information as may be required by the Federal Transit Administration.


**PART 8:** That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
