
City Attorney, Deborah Pullum – Gave a presentation explaining the reason for the Special Called City Council Meeting and how CenterPoint Energy wanted to raise the rates that would affect the business and citizens of the City of Tyler. She went on to speak about how CenterPoint also wanted to combine the Houston, Texas Coast and Beaumont/East Texas Region into one “Texas Region”. She spoke on the law and how as a member of the Steering Committee, the City of Tyler has the right to suspend the rate increase for a maximum of ninety days to review changes and ensure that the rate is fair.

With no further discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Hene; seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Curtis; motion carried 5-0 & approved as presented.
