

RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, COMMITTING THE CITY OF TYLER TO PERFORM OR CAUSE TO BE PERFORMED CERTAIN PROJECT(S) WITH NO REQUIRED MATCH FROM TXDOT; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER OR THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE, FINALIZE, AND EXECUTE A LOCAL ON-SYSTEM AGREEMENT (AND ANY AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS INCIDENT TO SAME) FOR SAID PURPOSES; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION WAS APPROVED COMPLIED WITH THE TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT; MAKING OTHER FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Chapters 201 and 221, authorize the State of Texas (the "State") to lay out, construct, maintain, and operate a system of streets, roads, and highways that comprise the State Highway System; and

WHEREAS, Government Code, Chapter 791, and Transportation Code, §201.209 and Chapter 221, authorize the State to contract with municipalities and political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tyler has requested that the State allow the City of Tyler to participate in the improvement described as " 2024 Pedestrian Access Improvement Project " (hereinafter referred to as the "Project") by funding said improvement; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated Project cost is \$272,220.00, and the City of Tyler commits to performing or causing to be performed the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation ("TXDOT") is not responsible for committing funds towards the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tyler shall be responsible for any cost overruns;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1. That the findings set out in the preamble to this resolution are hereby in all things approved and adopted.


PART 2. That the City of Tyler shall perform or cause to be performed the Project.

PART 3. That the City Manager or the City Manager's designee and any other official of the City as shall be required are hereby authorized and directed to negotiate, finalize, and execute, as approved by the City Attorney's Office, a Local On-System Agreement (and any and all other documents incident to same) by and between the City of Tyler and the State for the purposes of carrying out the Project mentioned in this resolution with no required match from TXDOT.

PART 4. That the meeting at which this resolution was approved was in all things conducted in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551.

PART 5. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
