



City of Tyler Utility Bill Use for Greenwood Farms Landfill

- 1. Present current photo ID:** The name or address on your ID must match the name or address on the water bill. On a case by case basis for extreme circumstances, such as disability or illness, we may grant the approval for someone else to use your water bill. Please call (903) 531-1388 and ask for the Customer Service Supervisor before you head to the landfill. Acceptable IDs include driver license, passports, concealed carry license, etc.
- 2. Good for 3 cubic yards only:** Any excess yardage is charged the current landfill gate rate, per yard.
3. Appliances are not covered by the utility bill.
- 4. City of Tyler utility bills are a one-time only use:** You may use the previous month utility bill if it was not used. We cannot use a utility bill that exceeds 45 days from the billing date. If you are an email only utility bill customer, you must print and bring the electronic notification information. Billing summaries are not accepted.
- 5. Original utility bills are accepted for use:** If you are not an email only customer, you must bring an original bill. Copies of original are not accepted, nor are the receipts of payment.
- 6. The top portion of the utility bill must be presented:** This contains the information needed to accept the City of Tyler utility bill.
7. No late (red) utility bills are accepted.
- 8. Residential bills only:** no commercial bills accepted for landfill use.
9. All loads must be tarped to avoid a “No Tarp” fee.

Use of the utility bill for free yardage is given by the City of Tyler for their residential customers. Greenwood Farms Landfill follows the rules set forth by the City of Tyler only. It is not up to Greenwood Farms Landfill to make exceptions.
