

**ORDINANCE NO. O-2019-24**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER,  
TEXAS, CANCELING DISTRICT SIX, CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL  
ELECTION SCHEDULED FOR MAY 4, 2019, AND DECLARING THE  
UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE FOR SINGLE MEMBER DISTRICT SIX  
ELECTED TO OFFICE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, a City Council Special Election is currently scheduled for May 4, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, no proposition is to appear on the ballot for the May 4, 2019 Special Election for District Six; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Clerk of the City of Tyler has certified in writing that the candidate for City Council District Six is unopposed and that no write-in candidates have filed to be placed on the list of write-in candidates; and

**WHEREAS**, Texas Election Code Sections 2.051 through 2.054 authorize the City Council to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office and to cancel the special election for said District;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:**

**PART 1.** That Criss Sudduth is hereby declared the duly elected City Council member for District Six to serve for a two-year term of office, to begin May 4, 2019.

**PART 2.** That the City Council Special Election for District Six scheduled for May 4, 2019, is hereby canceled.


**PART 3.** That a copy of this ordinance shall be posted on May 4, 2019 at each polling place that would have been used in the special election, and said notice shall be in both English and Spanish.

**PART 4.** That after May 4, 2019, a certificate of election shall be issued to the above named unopposed candidate for District Six in the same manner as provided for the candidate elected at the special election.

**PART 5.** That upon issuance of a certificate of election, the above named unopposed candidate for District Six shall be sworn into office in the same manner provided for the candidate elected at the special election.

**PART 6:** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


