

**RESOLUTION NO. R-2019-17**

**A RESOLUTION ORDERING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF TYLER ON THE 4TH DAY OF MAY, 2019, AMENDING THE POLLING LOCATIONS FOR A PREVIOUSLY CALLED ELECTION TO FILL THE OFFICE OF TYLER CITY COUNCIL MEMBER DISTRICT NUMBER 3; MAKING PROVISIONS FOR AND RESOLVING OTHER MATTERS INCIDENT AND RELATED TO SUCH ELECTION: REDUCING THE NUMBER OF VOTING LOCATIONS RELATED THERETO; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to hold an election to fill expiring terms of the Tyler City Council Members, and such election is required by law to be held the first Saturday in May; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 13, 2019, the Tyler City Council adopted Resolution No. R-2019-8, calling an Election for May 4, 2019 to fill the offices of the Tyler City Councilmembers for Single Member District Numbers 1, 3 and 5 on the Tyler City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 6, 2019, the Tyler City Council adopted Ordinance No. 0-2019-22, canceling the Election for Tyler City Council Member Districts 1 and 5 scheduled for May 4, 2019, declaring the unopposed candidates for Tyler City Council District Numbers 1 and 5 elected to office, leaving only Tyler City Council District No. 3; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 6, 2019, the Tyler City Council also adopted Resolution No. R-2019-13, calling a Special Election to be held with the regular Election on May 4, 2019, to fill the office of Tyler City Council Member for District 6, and calling for a joint election with Smith County, Tyler Independent School District and Whitehouse Independent School District; and

**WHEREAS**, the original number of polling places referenced in Resolution No. R-2019-8 is no longer necessary due to the reduced number of Tyler Councilmember District seats up for election;

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to reduce the number of voting locations for the May 4, 2019 election for remaining Tyler City Councilmember District 3; and

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution does not affect the number of voting locations or other provisions related to the Special Called Election for May 4, 2019, as referenced in Resolution Number R-2019-13;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:**

**PART 1:** That the voting places originally approved in Resolution No. R-2019-8 at the February 13, 2019 meeting shall be reduced as set forth below, as related to the regular Election on May 4, 2019, to fill the office of Tyler City Council Member District Number 3:


