

**RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-4**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT STATE GRANT FUNDING FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF ONE-HUNDRED AND FIFTY (150) OFFICER BODY WORN CAMERAS AT THE TYLER POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR ONE YEAR; DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE AS THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Tyler finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of Tyler that the established Body Camera State Grant Funding be utilized for Fiscal Year 2018/2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Tyler City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council designates the Key Leader of Finance as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant, to accept any increases in grant funding, and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant, on behalf of the applicant agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Criminal Justice Division State Grant BC- Body Worn Camera Program will fund the proposed equipment in the amount of \$60,000.00 for one year only with matching funds of \$15,000.00 from the City of Tyler, after which additional funding must be reapplied for;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS;**

**PART 1:** That the City Council of the City of Tyler approves the acceptance of State Grant funding through the Governor Criminal Justice Division in the amount of \$60,000.00 to assist in funding of one-hundred and fifty (150) body worn cameras for the Tyler Police Department with matching funds of \$15,000.00 from the City of Tyler for one year.

**PART 2:** That the Key Leader of Finance as the City of Tyler's authorized official, and is hereby authorized to apply for, reject, alter or terminate the grant, to accept any increases in grant funding, and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant, on behalf of the City of Tyler; and

**PART 3:** That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
