

RESOLUTION NO. R-2017-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE TYLER CITY MANAGER ON BEHALF OF THE TYLER FIRE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR'S FY2018 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM (SHSP) TO FUND PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS AIMED AT ENHANCING THE CITY'S ABILITY TO PREVENT, PROTECT AGAINST, RESPOND TO, AND RECOVER FROM TERRORIST ATTACKS AND OTHER DISASTERS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant is appropriated by the Department of Homeland Security and is designed to enhance the ability of local governments to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from terrorist attacks and other disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor's Homeland Security Grant Division (HSGD) currently serves as the Texas State Administrative Agency for the FY2018 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tyler finds it in the best interest of the City of Tyler to apply for grant funding for the following projects under the FY2018 SHSP:

1. Hazard Materials Detection and Identification
2. Upgrades to Regional Communications Capability
3. Public Notifications and Communication
4. Personal Protective Equipment for Active Shooter Response
5. Emergency Lighting for Regional HazMat Trailer; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tyler agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of FY2018 SHSP funds, the City Council of the City of Tyler assures the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tyler authorizes the Tyler City Manager as the City's authorized official with the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, terminate and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant, including acceptance of any increases in the grant amount, on behalf of the City of Tyler;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS;

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas approves the submission of grant applications for the above named projects to the Office of the Governor's FY2018 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP); and


PART 2: That the City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas designates the Tyler City Manager as the City's authorized official, and is hereby authorized to apply for, accept, reject,

alter, terminate and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant, including acceptance of any increases in the grant amount, on behalf of the City of Tyler; and

PART 3: That the City Council of the City of Tyler agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of FY2018 SHSP funds, the City Council of the City of Tyler assures the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor; and

PART 4: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
