

RESOLUTION NO. R-2017-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, TO FUND FOUR OFFICERS' POSITIONS AT THE TYLER POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THREE YEARS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS RELATED TO THE GRANT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tyler finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Tyler to operate for the 2017-2018 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the COPS Hiring funds, the Tyler City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the COPS Hiring in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the Tyler City Manager to be the authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, the COPS Hiring Grant will fund four new positions in the amount of \$684,218.00 for three years only, after which additional funding must be provided for at least one year; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Tyler approves the acceptance of the COPS Hiring Grant in the amount of \$ 684,218.00 to assist in funding of four officer positions at the Tyler Police Department for three years.

PART 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for, reject, alter, terminate, and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant on behalf of the City of Tyler;

PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
