

RESOLUTION NO. R-2015-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS EXPRESSING THE CITY COUNCIL'S SUPPORT FOR AND AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE A DEFENSE AND INDEMNIFICATION TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES AND CONTRACT EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE BEEN SUED AS A RESULT OF ACTIONS TAKEN AS CITY EMPLOYEES AND/OR CONTRACT EMPLOYEES; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, certain employees and contract employees have been sued as a result of actions taken as City employees and/or contract employees in a lawsuit entitled: *Joseph Cotten vs. City of Tyler, Et Al.; Cause No. 2:15-CV-00520, United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas.*; and

WHEREAS, the City's investigation of the events involved in this lawsuit and the evidence available at this time, show that these employees and contract employees were acting in good faith and acted appropriately in the course and scope of their duties as City employees and/or contract employees; and


WHEREAS, it is in the public interest as well as the individual employees' and contract employees' interest for the City Council to state officially its support for them by providing a defense and agreeing to their indemnification, based upon all information and evidence available to date;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:


