

RESOLUTION NO. R-2015-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, APPOINTING MICAH ALSOBROOKS AS THE LOCAL REGISTRAR FOR THE CITY OF TYLER AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to promote the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an authorized Cooperative Agreement between the City of Tyler and Smith County, both entities are operating members of the Northeast Texas Public Health District (aka NET Health and herein referred to as "District") ; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Agreement states that the Chief Operating Officer of the District shall appoint the Local Registrar for the NET Health registration district, of which the City of Tyler is a part, pursuant to Chapter 191 of the Texas Health and Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, with the recent retirement of the long time Director of Vital Statistics, the District has appointed Micah Alsobrooks as Interim Director of Vital Statistics; and

WHEREAS, Micah Alsobrooks has worked in Vital Statistics for 13 years and has been designated as a Master Registrar by the Texas Department of State Health Services; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Vital Statistics has traditionally served as the Local Registrar for the City of Tyler; and

WHEREAS, the District's Chief Executive Officer proposes and the Board of Health has approved the appointment of Micah Alsobrooks as the Local Registrar for the City of Tyler; and


WHEREAS, state law and the Cooperative Agreement require that the City of Tyler consider and approve this appointment; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1. That the City Council accept the recommendation of the Northeast Texas Public Health District Chief Executive Officer and the Board of Health to approve the appointment of Micah Alsobrooks as the Local Registrar for the City of Tyler

PART 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
