

ORDINANCE NO. O-2019-35

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS,
AFFIRMING THE CANCELLATION OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION FOR CITY
COUNCIL DISTRICT NO. 6, AFFIRMING THE DESIGNATION OF THE
UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE AS THE WINNER FOR CITY COUNCILMEMBER
DISTRICT NO. 6; DECLARING THE RESULTS; AND ESTABLISHING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, a City Council Special Election for City Council District. 6 was scheduled for May 4, 2019; and

WHEREAS, no proposition was to appear on the ballot for the May 4, 2019 Special Election for District Six; and

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code Sections 2.051 through 2.054 authorize the City Council to declare the unopposed candidate elected to office and cancel the unneeded special election;

WHEREAS, on March 29, 2019, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 0-2019-24, cancelling the Special Election scheduled City Council District 6 for May 4, 2019, and declaring the unopposed candidate for City Council District 6 elected to office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:


PART 1: That Criss Sudduth be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 6, to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term of the Councilmember who vacated said seat (i.e. former Councilmember John Nix).

PART 2: That the City Council special election for District No. 6, scheduled for May 4, 2019, was cancelled by Ordinance No. 0-2019-24 and the unopposed candidate declared the winner, and such cancellation and declaration are hereby affirmed.

PART 3: That, pursuant to Tyler City Charter Sec. 17, "Filling vacancies", the above named City Councilmember for District No. 6 shall be sworn into office and shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term of the Councilmember who vacated said seat (circa one year), or until their successor has been duly elected and qualified.

PART 4: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
