

ORDINANCE NO. O-2018-56

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER,
TEXAS, ADOPTING THE HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAM'S
FAMILY SELF SUFFICIENCY PROGRAM FY 2018 ANNUAL PLAN AND
ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) is a HUD program that encourages communities to develop local strategies to assist voucher families in obtaining employment that will lead to economic independence and self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that such proposed programs be approved by City Council, subject to approval and allocation by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tyler is proposing implementation of its Housing Choice Voucher Program's Family Self Sufficiency FY 2018 Annual Plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1:: That the proposed program plans attached as Exhibit A be made a part hereof for all purposes and are hereby approved, subject to approval and allocation by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

PART 2: That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to submit the Housing Choice Voucher Program's Family Self Sufficiency FY 2018 Annual Plan on or before the submission deadline.


PART 3: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
