

**ORDINANCE NO. O-2018-56**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAM'S FAMILY SELF SUFFICIENCY PROGRAM FY 2018 ANNUAL PLAN AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) is a HUD program that encourages communities to develop local strategies to assist voucher families in obtaining employment that will lead to economic independence and self-sufficiency; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the public interest that such proposed programs be approved by City Council, subject to approval and allocation by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Tyler is proposing implementation of its Housing Choice Voucher Program's Family Self Sufficiency FY 2018 Annual Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:**

**PART 1::** That the proposed program plans attached as Exhibit A be made a part hereof for all purposes and are hereby approved, subject to approval and allocation by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

**PART 2:** That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to submit the Housing Choice Voucher Program's Family Self Sufficiency FY 2018 Annual Plan on or before the submission deadline.

**PART 3:** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
