

RESOLUTION NO. R-2020-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE TYLER 1ST PLAN AS A GUIDE FOR MAKING DECISIONS FOR THE GROWTH AND FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF THE CITY OF TYLER; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to promote the welfare of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Tyler 1st Plan developed a vision statement and principles to be used as guidelines in providing more specific direction concerning improvements and growth for the City of Tyler; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission has held a public hearing and is recommending the final adoption of the Tyler 1st Plan; and

WHEREAS, it is considered to be in the public interest for the City Council to adopt the Tyler 1st planning documents that will be used as a guide for future development and prioritization for projects and public spending; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent that this Tyler 1st Plan will be a guide subject to continued review and amendments as needed to ensure that it stays a current and useful planning tool;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:


PART 1: That the Tyler 1st Comprehensive Plan as developed through the process and with various comments included as a result of final public input and which is attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby approved and adopted by the City Council, and is incorporated herein; and

PART 2: That it is the intent of the City Council that a formal review process of the plan be continued with opportunities for additional public input as well as a periodic presentation by City staff to the City Council.

PART 3: That the City Council expresses its appreciation to all of those persons who have contributed to this process by investing their time and ideas for the future improvement of Tyler.

PART 4: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
