PARK HOURS

All City parks are open from sunrise to sunset and all trails are open at 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Exceptions may apply when activities sponsored or sanctioned by the Parks and Recreation Department are in progress and for thirty minutes after the conclusion of such activities. It is unlawful to enter a park or remain in a park during hours when a park is closed.

RESERVATIONS

The amphitheater, pavilions and picnic tables may be rented for your next special event. To make a reservation, please complete a Special Event Permit and submit it to the Parks and Recreation office along with the permit fee. 
