

RESOLUTION NO. R-2021-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION BY THE TYLER POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR, AND ACCEPTANCE OF, FUNDING THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE UNDER THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF: TASERS AND ALL IMPLEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH TASERS AND CRIME SCENE EQUIPMENT AND ALL ACCESSORIES ASSOCIATED WITH FORENSIC INVESTIGATIONS. DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS RELATED TO ACCEPTANCE AND USE OF THE GRANT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tyler finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Tyler that the established Justice Assistance Grant Funding be utilized for 2021/2022 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Tyler City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Key Leader of Finance as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant, to accept any increases in grant funding, and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant, on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Division JAG Grant will fund the proposed equipment up to \$34,000.00 for one year only, after which additional funding must be reapplied for;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS;

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Tyler approves the application and the acceptance of Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant funding through the Department of Justice and is not to exceed \$34,000.00 to assist in funding of Tasers and all implements associated with Tasers, and crime scene equipment and all accessories associated with forensic investigations for the Tyler Police Department for one year.

PART 2: That the Key Leader of Finance as the City of Tyler's authorized official, and is hereby authorized to apply for, reject, alter or terminate the grant, to accept any increases in grant funding, and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant, on behalf of the City of Tyler; and

PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
