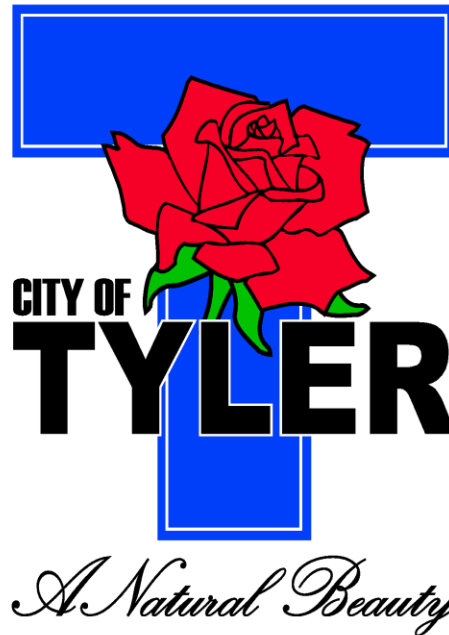

MINUTES

Request that the City Council consider approving the minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas held on June 23, 2021.

ORDINANCE

- O-1** Request that the City Council consider adopting an Ordinance amending Tyler City Code Chapter 17, to include new bicycle routes associated with the Bike Stripes project, to remove portions of old bicycle routes that are no longer applicable due to the Bike Stripes project, deleting driving and parking restrictions associated with exclusive bicycle lanes, deleting unnecessary references to penalties, and amending the official map to show all designated signed bicycle routes within the City of Tyler.

- M-1** Request that the City Council consider authorizing the City Manager to execute an engineering contract with The CT Brannon Corporation for the Grande Boulevard Reverse Curve Preliminary Engineering Report and Highway Safety Improvement project screening and applications in the amount of \$95,943.00.
- M-2** Request that the City Council consider ratifying expenditures in the amount of \$53,439.30 for work performed for the emergency repair of a storm pipe located under the street on the 100 block of E. Houston Street.
- M-3** Request that the City Council consider authorizing the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Reynolds & Kay, Ltd for the construction of the Holly Park Drainage Improvements project in the amount of \$434,760.70.
- M-4** Request that the City Council consider authorizing the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Reynolds & Kay, Ltd for the construction of the Cloverdale Drainage Improvements project in the amount of \$3,356,265.70.
- M-5** Request the City Council consider ratifying payment of \$297,724.14 to A.E. Shull & Company for the completed emergency repair of a 24-inch sanitary sewer line, manhole rehabilitation, sewer line re-alignment recovery flow from Delek Refining and access road 0.6 of a mile long to the site to be paid out of Water Capital funds.

- M-6** Request that the City Council consider authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with C & A Construction in the amount of \$423,250.74 for the Group 2 Sanitary Sewer Reroutes and Rehabilitation Standard Bid, 21-051.
- M-7** Request that the City Council consider authorizing the City Manager to execute an Engineering Services Contract, in an amount not to exceed \$1,850,000, with Langan | Adams for the Consent Decree Group 4 Remedial Measures Implementation.
- M-8** Request that the City Council consider authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with Garver in the amount of \$838,541.00 for the Engineering Services for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Master Plan.

- C-A-4** Request that the City Council consider authorizing the City Manager to purchase two Nissan Sentra to be used by the Police Department and one Nissan Kick from Peltier Nissan Tyler, Texas for a total cost of \$71,614.04.
