

RESOLUTION NO. R-2021-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, AS THE DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE STATE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND MAKE PAYMENT OF SAID FUNDS FOR \$97,677.00 AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation has approved projects for:

FM 756 from Jeff Davis Dr (CR1167), S to FM 346

FM 2964 from SH 110, Tyler S to FM 346;

SH 31 from SL 323, in Tyler E to CR 236, MPO Bndry, 1.6 Mi E of FM 757

FM 2493 from SL 323 in Tyler S to FM 2813

WHEREAS, the State has requested the City to enter into Contractual Agreements and acquire right of way on the above referenced project; and

WHEREAS, the City has now requested that the State assume responsibility for acquisition of all necessary right of way; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to voluntarily contribute to the State funds equal to 0.5 percent of the cost of the right of way for the proper development and construction of the State Highway System,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

Part 1: That the City Manager of Tyler be authorized to execute for and on behalf of the CITY OF TYLER the Agreement to Contribute Funds with the State in the amount equal to 0.5% of the cost to cover the right of way acquisition, proper development, and/or construction, and the City Secretary is directed to attest this agreement with the State and to affix the seal of the City of Tyler thereto.

Part 2: It is further resolved that the City Manager is authorized to execute on behalf of the CITY OF TYLER any supplemental agreements or further modifications to the above referenced agreement.

Part 3: That a copy of said agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully set out herein.

Part 4: That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval.
