

RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, RESOLVING TO SUPPORT THE GOALS AND IDEALS FOR THE 2020 CENSUS AND WILL DISSEMINATE 2020 CENSUS INFORMATION TO ENCOURAGE PARTICIPATION, ASK AFFILIATES AND MEMBERSHIP TO WORK TOGETHER TO ACHIEVE AN ACCURATE AND COMPLETE COUNT, AND TO ENCOURAGE PEOPLE IN OUR COMMUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN EVENTS AND INITIATIVES THAT WILL RAISE THE OVERALL AWARENESS OF THE 2020 CENSUS AND INCREASE PARTICIPATION AMONG ALL POPULATIONS AND ESTABLISH A COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE IN COOPERATION WITH ALL OTHER AGENCIES WITHIN SMITH COUNTY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by the U.S. Constitution to conduct a count of the population and provides a historic opportunity to help shape the foundation of our society and play an active role in American democracy; and

WHEREAS, it is important to seek to ensure that every resident is counted; and

WHEREAS, billions of dollars in federal and state funding is allocated to communities, and decisions are made on matters of national and local importance based, in part, on census data, including health care, community development, housing, education, transportation, social services, employment and much more; and

WHEREAS, census data helps to determine how many seats each state will have in the U.S. House of Representatives and often is used for the redistricting of state legislatures, county and city governing bodies and voting districts; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Census creates hundreds of thousands of jobs across the nation; and

WHEREAS, under Title 13, U.S. Code, all Census Bureau employees swear a lifetime oath to protect respondent data, and under Title 44, U.S. Code, the Census Bureau must ensure that individual records from the decennial censuses remain confidential for 72 years; and

WHEREAS, a united voice from business, government, community-based and faith-based organizations, educators, media and others will allow the 2020 Census message to reach a broader audience, providing trusted advocates who can spark positive conversations about the 2020 Census; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and advisable that this Resolution be adopted, and that adoption of this Resolution is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:


DECEMBER 2018: In order to raise public awareness, the Census Bureau partnered up with local governments and organizations to raise awareness of the census and to actively pursue historically underrepresented and hard to reach populations.

The United States Census Bureau provided assistance through a program called the Complete Count Committee (CCC).

A presentation and request was made to City of Tyler Council to establish a CCC in Tyler.

A Resolution was recommended and approved to support and authorize the establishment of a Complete Count Committee to include community partners within Smith County.

2020 Census Complete Count Committee



A 2020 Census Complete Count Committees (CCC) was established with local government and community leaders throughout the East Texas Region with the mission and purpose of highlighting the message that the 2020 Census is imminent and that it is easy, important and safe to participate.

- CCC Recruitment – July/Aug. 2018
- CCC Establishment – December 2018
- CCC Launches First Meeting – January 2019
- Area Census Office Opens – October 2019
- CCC Schedules Meetings, Structure of the CCC, and its Planned Efforts – Jan. 2019 through Feb. 2020

COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE

JANUARY 2019: The Complete Count Committee launched its first committee meeting to meet and greet all volunteers and state purpose and mission of the CCC.

FEBRUARY 2019: Complete Count Committee learned more about the data and resources available from the Census Bureau. Such resources included the ROAM (Responsive Outreach Area Mapper).

APRIL 2019: CCC discussed and brainstormed on appropriate pathways to conduct outreach to all communities, including the hard-to-reach population groups.

JUNE-AUGUST 2019: Complete Count Committee was renamed “You Count East Texas” during CCC meeting time. Sub-Committee work groups and chairs were established: Government, Media, Education, Nonprofit, Hispanic, African American, Veteran, Faith-Based Communities.

SEPTEMBER 2019: Census 2020 Outreach at HBA Hispanic Heritage Kick-Off Celebration event Rose City Fiesta

OCTOBER 2019: Grand Opening of Area Census Office.

NOVEMBER 2019: CCC Social Media platforms were established and made available to the public.

DECEMBER 2019: Complete Count Committee finalized its list of 2020 community outreach events and location where Census participation would provide education and awareness.



FEBRUARY 2020: Met with the Census Outreach Area Representative and finalized additional outreach initiatives that the CCC would assist within each representatives' communities.

MARCH 2020: CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC - ALL CAME TO A STANDSTILL AND ALL PLANNED INITIATIVES WERE CANCELED, INCLUDING THE CENSUS BUREAU'S EMPLOYEES VISITING HOMES TO COMPLETE SELF RESPONSE SURVEYS IN PERSON – WHICH WAS SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 1ST.





