

ORDINANCE NO. O-2021-71

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE FAMILY SELF SUFFICIENCY AND HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAMS' FY 2021-2022 ANNUAL PLANS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is intent of the City Council to promote the public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, for many years the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has allocated funds through annual contribution contracts to the City of Tyler for housing assistance programs, along with administrative costs associated with such programs; and

WHEREAS, Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) is a HUD program that encourages communities to develop local strategies to assist voucher families in obtaining employment that will lead to economic independence and self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that such proposed programs be approved by the City Council, subject to approval and allocation by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tyler is proposing implementation of its Family Self Sufficiency and Housing Choice Voucher Programs' FY 2021-2022 Annual Plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the proposed program plans attached as Exhibit A be made a part hereof for all purposes and are hereby approved, subject to approval and allocation by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

PART 2: That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to submit the Family Self Sufficiency and Housing Choice Voucher Programs' FY 2021-2022 Annual Plans on or before the submission deadline(s).

PART 3: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
