Teams

Companies may enter one co-ed team in the kickball tournament consisting of at least eight players with a maximum of ten players. There must be eight players in the field, one of which must play the catcher position. In the event there are only seven players, the eighth spot in the batting lineup will be considered an automatic out.

Defense Play

The half inning is complete when three outs are achieved. Outs are achieved the following ways:

- Any combination of three strikes and/or foul balls
- A fielder catching the ball prior to it hitting the ground or making contact with another surface
- A force out where the fielder tags a base before the runner arrives at the base
- A runner touched by a ball or who touches a ball while not on the base
 - Throws towards runners must hit the runner below the neck and head. Any runner hit in the neck or head shall be called safe. A runner may be called out if he or she purposely tries to block the ball with his or her head.

Pitchers must deliver the ball with one foot in contact with the rubber. The ball must be rolling or have bounced a minimum of two times prior to reaching home plate to be counted a fair pitch.

Offense Play

Kickers must wait to kick the ball until the ball crosses the front of the strike zone. A kick made in front of the strike zone will be considered foul.

Baserunners are not allowed to steal or lead off. Sliding or diving is not allowed. Runners will advance one base if the ball goes out of play while the defense is attempting to make an out.

Winner of a game

Games will be limited to 45 minutes or four innings. If an inning had begun prior to the 45-minute time limit, the inning will be allowed to finish. After three full innings of play,

if a team is behind in score by ten or more runs after completing their half of the inning as the kicking team, the game is over.

Tie Breaker

In the event the game ends in a tie, the accuracy kick will be used to determine the winner. Each team will select one kicker. The kicker will have one kick from home plate. The team who's kicker who lands their ball closest to second base shall be awarded the win.
