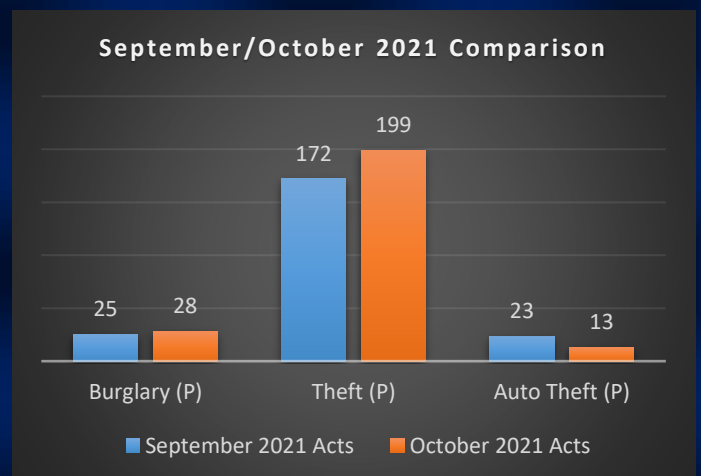
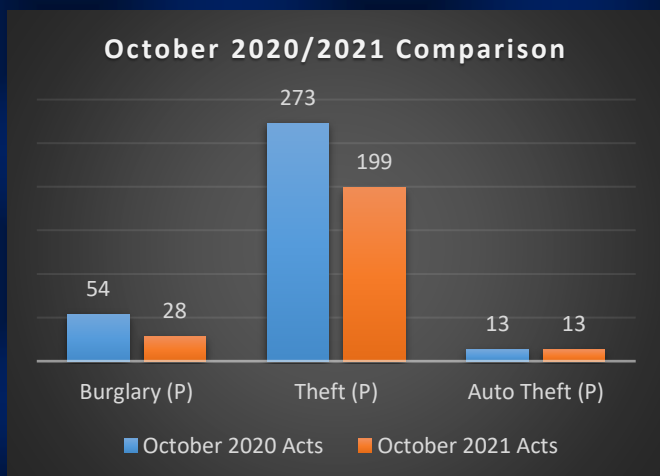

There is a downward trend for part 1 property crimes when comparing October 2021 to October 2020. There is an upward trend for part 1 property crimes when comparing October 2021 to September 2021.

October 2021, overall property crimes had a decrease of 29% compared to October 2020 and had a 9% increase compared to September 2021.

There was a decrease in burglary (-48%) and theft (-27%) offenses when comparing October 2021 to October 2020. There was no change in auto-theft offenses when comparing October 2021 to October 2020.

There was a decrease in auto-theft (-43%) offenses when comparing October 2021 to September 2021. There was an increase in burglary (12%) and theft (16%) offenses when comparing October 2021 to September 2021.
