



Recycled Art Contest 2023 , “Don’t Trash Texas!”

Contest Rules

Keep Tyler Beautiful is sponsoring a Recycled Art Contest themed, “Don’t Trash Texas!”. The contest is open to all Tyler Area students and adults, there will be two separate judging categories.

- Entries must be completed by individuals, not groups with only one entry per person.
- Artist name must not be visible on front of artwork.
- An entry form must be completed and submitted with the artwork.
 - Take multiple, clear pictures of the artwork and submit with entry form to ktyb@tylertexas.com.
 - If artwork is a sculpture or has a 3D element, please submit at least 3 pictures of the artwork including multiple angles.
 - **Pictures and entry form must be submitted no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, March 3, 2022.**
- Artwork will be judged by select members of Keep Tyler Beautiful and the City of Tyler Parks and Recreation Department. The top three (3) winners in each category will be recognized with their artwork displayed at the Great Tyler Cleanup on April 1, 2023 where the will receive a certificate and a Brookshire’s giftcard of \$5, \$10, or \$20 value. Winners will be notified through the email provided on the entry form.
- Select entries, including winners, may be selected to be displayed during the “Art in the Garden” Exhibit in April – May 2023 at the Rose Garden Center, located at 420 Rose Park Drive Tyler, Texas. Artists will be responsible for picking up their artwork after the event.
- **Artwork Specifications**
 - This year’s theme is “Don’t Trash Texas”, artwork about Texas or incorporating Texas themes will earn extra points.
 - Please only use art materials and recycled materials for artworks. Don’t include items such as food waste or hazardous material.
 - Artwork must not exceed 15”x 15” x 25”.
 - 3D Artwork must be freestanding.
 - Artwork must be free of any vulgar, obscene or otherwise inappropriate words, phrases or imagery.
- **Judging Criteria**
 - 25% - Use of theme
 - 25% - Overall presentation and aesthetic
 - 50% - Creative use of recycled materials
